Frauenkonferenz der Tschechisch – Slowakischen Union



„Eine Frau ist wie eine Perle“

Vom 26. – 27.10.2019 fand in Brno die Frauenkonferenz der Tschechisch – Slowakischen Union statt. Teilgenommen haben 180 Frauen aus den drei Vereinigungen (Böhmen, Mähren, Schlesien und Slowakei).



Das Motto war „Eine Frau ist wie eine Perle“ und der Leittext aus Sprüche 31, 25. Die Besonderheit und der Wert, den Gott uns gibt wurden durch verschiedene Perlen Symbole vor Augen geführt, sei es durch die Deko, ein Perlenarmband oder Perlenförmige Schokolade usw. Eine Schmuckdesignerin führte u.a. den Prozess der Perlenentstehung vor Augen. Nur durch einen Fremdkörper, der in die Muschel eindringt, kann etwas so Wunderschönes wie eine Perle entstehen. Dagmar Dorn brachte dies auch in ihrer Predigt zum Ausdruck. Niemand liebt schmerzhaft Prozesse im Leben aber jede von uns ist damit vertraut. Gott aber kann daraus etwas Wunderschönes entstehen lassen, was anderweitig nicht möglich gewesen wäre. Gott nutzt Negatives in unserem Leben, was durch die Gebrochenheit unserer Welt entstanden ist und kehrt es um so dass es zu seiner Ehre dienen kann. Die Geschichte von Noemi ist ein biblisches Beispiel.
