10-MINUTE COOKBOOK




ZOOM MEETING OF WOMEN'S MINISTRIES TEAM IN BADEN-WÜRTTEMBERG

RELAUNCH AFTER THE LOCKDOWN

On Sabbath June 13, 2020, many Adventist local churches in Italy were not yet opened after the lockdown, so the Women's Ministries department made a special video message and sermon for the women to celebrate the Women's Ministries Emphasis Day. «Christ's Amazing Love Moves Me» was the theme of the video that was watched on demand on the web television Hope Channel Italy. There were over 200 views.

The WM national coordinator Lina Ferrara preached in the Lungotevere church, the oldest Adventist church in Rome. The sermon was also broadcast live on the Facebook page of the local church. The women were happy to celebrate the WM special day on the second Sabbath of their church reopening. We were not able to hold any program in the afternoon due to the restrictions set out in the hygiene protocol to contain the Covid-19 virus.



For the women in Lungotevere, it has been very important to restart with a sermon with physical presence, even wearing masks and observing the safe distance. It was like picking up where they had left off. In fact, the lockdown in Italy began on March 4, therefore it was not possible to hold the International Women's Day of Prayer on Sabbath March 7.

Prior to coming to the General Conference in 2001, Heather-Dawn Small held the position of Children's and Women's Ministries director for five years for the Caribbean Union Conference. Heather-Dawn earned a master's degree in leadership with emphasis in pastoral care to women. She is presently a candidate for a doctorate degree in leadership. Small works with women all over the world. She encourages Adventist women to fully utilize their talents,

provides leadership training and resource materials, and works closely with church administrators to learn how Women's Ministries programs can complement and support existing programs in the church. "The biggest obstacle to accepting women as leaders is our mindset," said Small. "We need a change in mindset so that when we think of leadership, we don't automatically think of men. We must re-frame our mindset to include women."

The Church's Calendar of Days and Events contains three special days for Women's Ministries

International Women's Day of Prayer (first Sabbath in March) This is a special day when women have the opportunity to strengthen their spiritual bonds as they pray for and with

each other.

Women's Ministries Emphasis Day (second Sabbath in June) It is an opportunity for women to lead out in a worship service and a chance to educate the church regarding the purposes of Women's Ministries.

enditnow Emphasis Day (fourth Sabbath in August). Renamed enditnow® Emphasis Day in 2014, the fourth Sabbath in August was originally designated Abuse Prevention Emphasis Day.

Women's Ministries coordinates the production and distribution of resource packets on all these days

Six critical Issues that particularly impact Women



#SDAWOMENSMINISTRIES25 - 10 DID YOU KNOW?

The Department of Women's Ministries chose to address six critical issues that particularly impact women around the world. These are certainly challenges for everyone in the church:

- Illiteracy
- Abuse
- Poverty
- Health risks
- Work loads
- Lack of mentoring and leadership training

Before much can be done to address most of these needs, a person must be able to read. Almost one billion adults cannot read; about three-fourths of these are women. They cannot read the instructions on a medicine bottle, fill out an employment form, or read the directions for a household cleaner. Neither can they read a Sabbath School lesson to a child nor read the Bible.
